Purpose of the Family Council

The Family Council guides the household community through shared leadership, accountable decision-making, and protection of the Family Covenant. It prevents both chaos and tyranny and ensures stability during crisis.

Council Structure

Record how the council is formed, how long members serve, and how rotation prevents power concentration.

Authority and Responsibilities

The Council coordinates resources, maintains records, ensures fairness, and upholds the Covenant.

Limits of Authority

The Council may not violate rights, override supermajority rules, or act without transparency.

Decision Making Rules

Document criteria for ordinary, survival level, and emergency decisions.

Signatures

Council members affirm their commitment to serve the family community.
