## **Section 1 — Role Overview**

Adolescents (ages 13–17) are apprentices of responsibility, taking on meaningful duties while training toward independence under adult guidance. They bridge child and adult roles, learning discipline, follow-through, and service.

## ***Section 2 — Duties Checklist***

- [ ] Assist with light security or watch duties
  - [ ] Help manage garden beds or compost
  - [ ] Complete assigned sanitation tasks
  - [ ] Support documentation or recordkeeping
  - [ ] Train under at least two Core Role mentors
  - [ ] Attend family Council with voice (no vote)
  - [ ] Rotate through labor, safety, and service roles
  - [ ] Debrief regularly about stress and workload
