Section 1 — Role Overview

Adolescents (ages 13–17) are apprentices of responsibility, taking on meaningful duties while training toward independence under adult guidance. They bridge child and adult roles, learning discipline, follow-through, and service.

Section 2 — Duties Checklist

- ☐ Assist with light security or watch duties
- ☐ Help manage garden beds or compost
- ☐ Complete assigned sanitation tasks
- ☐ Support documentation or recordkeeping
- ☐ Train under at least two Core Role mentors
- ☐ Attend family Council with voice (no vote)
- ☐ Rotate through labor, safety, and service roles
- ☐ Debrief regularly about stress and workload
