Children (ages 5–12) serve as apprentices of order, learning through guided contribution, simple chores, and supervised participation in family routines. Their tasks must be safe, age-appropriate, and framed as training rather than burden.

Section 2 — Duties Checklist

- ☐ Sort light supplies with supervision
- ☐ Mark checklists or logs when asked
- ☐ Feed animals or pets safely
- ☐ Water plants or help in the garden
- ☐ Carry small items during chores
- ☐ Participate in supervised drills
- ☐ Attend safety and moral instruction
- ☐ Practice calm responses during emergencies
