#### Humanitarian Aid Guide

Compassion is part of the covenant, but it must be practiced within safe boundaries. All aid is offered outside the gate and never at the expense of the family's survival.

#### Safe Aid Options

| Type of Aid | Guidelines  |
|-------------|---|
| Water       | Offer small, measured amounts in a separate container. Do not reveal full stores. |
| Food        | Single meal or snack only; no bulk rations. Provide outside the gate.             |
| First Aid   | Basic bandage or antiseptic only. Avoid exposing medical stores.                  |
| Information | General directions or weather; no disclosure of defenses, routines, or supplies.  |

#### Aid Boundaries

| Boundary                             | Reason   |
|--------------------------------------|--|
| No home entry for strangers.         | Prevents mapping of layout, resources, and routines.         |
| No promises of future support.       | Avoids resentment or dependency if future aid is impossible. |
| No aid when clear threat is present. | Protection of household must remain primary.                 |
